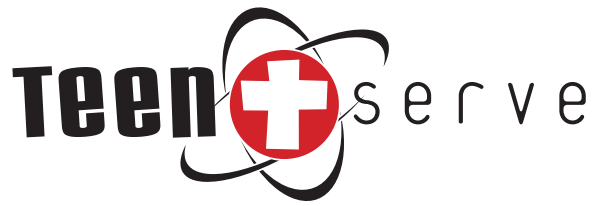

Skills needed – truck or large van to transport materials.
Time Investment - Monday-Thursday 4:30pm or 5:00pm

_____ **Ladders/Materials Pick-up from Worksites**
Responsibilities – Go to worksites and pick up ladders and/or materials
Skills needed – truck or large van to transport ladders and materials.
Time Investment – Friday late afternoon and/or Saturday morning.

_____ **Kitchen Assistant (PLEASE CHECK A SHIFT BELOW)**
Responsibilities - assist with the preparation of meals and clean up the cafeteria after meals, take direction from school cooking staff.
Skills needed - food preparation skills, a servant's heart
 _____ **Shift One** - 6:00am to 9:00am- Monday-Saturday _____ **Shift Two** - 3:00pm to 7:00pm- **Sunday-Friday**

_____ **Photo Guides (LOCAL PERSON WHO KNOWS THE AREA)**
Responsibilities - Drive TeenServe staff to worksites so they can take crew photographs
Skills needed - knowledge of the area; dependable vehicle for transportation
Time Investment - 8:30 a.m. to Noon and/or 12:30pm to 3:00pm on Monday through Thursday.

_____ **Coffee House Worker (16 years minimum age requirement)**
Responsibilities – Assist TeenServe staff in the operation of the coffee house during evening free time.
Skills needed – Will train to run popcorn machine, smoothie machine, clean-up.

VOLUNTEER CODE OF CONDUCT

- I will not use alcohol or illegal drugs during the workcamp week, or at any time while I am performing duties as a member of staff. I will not engage in excessive or illegal alcohol use or the use of illicit drugs while I am in the service of TeenServe, including during travel, set-up, whether "on" or "off" duty.
- I will refrain from smoking or using smokeless tobacco products indoors during workcamp week. I will honor the host school's tobacco policy at all times while staying or working at the school.
- I will respect and serve all those who attend our workcamps. I will strictly avoid sexual, exclusive, or other potentially harmful actions or relationships with workcamp participants and other staff members, whether volunteer or TeenServe staff members. I will also avoid creating the perception of any of the described inappropriate behaviors.
- I will strive to treat workcamp participants, residents, school/co-sponsor personnel, members of the host community, and my co-workers, whether volunteer or TeenServe staff, with dignity, honor, and courtesy at all times.
- I will act responsibly to obtain the nourishment and rest I need to keep myself physically fit and mentally alert, and able to deliver my best performance during all working hours.
- I will maintain a professional appearance, adhering to TeenServe's dress code at all times.
- I will protect all TeenServe property and vehicles entrusted to my care during my time of service to TeenServe.
- I will observe all applicable federal, state, and local laws during my service with TeenServe.
- I will conduct myself at all times as a professional representative of TeenServe. I will refrain from action, word, or innuendo that could cause embarrassment, damage, or injury to TeenServe's reputation, property, or personnel, permanent or temporary.

RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS *Volunteer*

I, _____, the undersigned volunteer or parent (if volunteer is under age 18), am participating in the TeenServe workcamp(s) during the dates _____ to _____. I hereby agree to freely and expressly assume and accept any and all risks of injury or death to myself while participating in the Mission Experience.

I also hereby grant permission to TeenServe and Cross-Walk Ministries, Inc. to photograph and/or videotape and to record my voice and sounds, and to use any or all such photographs, recordings, and reproductions thereof (in and/or as a part of) any motion picture, video production, website, and/or any related published products.

In consideration for being accepted by TeenServe and Cross-Walk Ministries, Inc., a non-profit Wisconsin Corporation, hereafter called TeenServe, for participation in this TeenServe Workcamp, I, being 18 years of age or older or parent of a volunteer under the age of 18, do for myself hereby release, forever discharge, and agree to forever hold harmless TeenServe, Cross-Walk Ministries, Inc., the directors, officers, employees, and agents thereof, from any and all liability, claims, and demands for personal injury, sickness, and death, as well as property damage and expenses of any nature whatsoever and any loss or damage in connection with or arising out of or resulting from any or all activities engaged in by me while participating in the TeenServe Workcamp, during the time period specified above.

I agree not to make a claim or to sue Cross-Walk Ministries, Inc., TeenServe, the School District or Co-Sponsor Teams, for injuries or damages relating to my or my child's participation in TeenServe Workcamp for the period of time specified in the above paragraph.

I have carefully read this permission authorization and release of all claims, and fully understand its contents. I am aware that this is a release of liability and a contract between myself and Cross-Walk Ministries, Inc., TeenServe, the School District and Co-Sponsor Teams, and I sign it of my own free will.

The undersigned further agrees to hold harmless and indemnify TeenServe, Cross-Walk Ministries, Inc., or Co-Sponsor Teams, the School District, their directors, officers, employees, and agents, for any loss, claim, liability, damage, including property damage and all other injury whatsoever incurred by me as a result of the negligent, willful, or intentional acts of said participant, including reasonable attorneys' fees and other expenses incurred attendant thereto.

This **Release of all Claims** shall be construed and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Wisconsin. I expressly agree that this Release is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of Wisconsin, and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect. All of the provisions of this Release are separable, so if any provision of this Release is held to be ineffective by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this Release shall remain in full force and effect unless the invalidated provision is so fundamental to this Release that the remaining provisions do not reflect the parties' intent.
