AND
PERMISSION AUTHORIZATION

PERMISSION AUTHORIZATION

I, _____, the undersigned participant, or parent or legal guardian of a participant who is under the age of 18, hereby give my permission to Cross-Walk Ministries, Inc., for participation in the Mission Experience for the dates _____ to _____.

I understand that Cross-Walk Ministries, Inc., and Teen Serve are providing a short-term mission experience ("Mission Experience"), in which participants will be expected to join in mission activities including, but not limited to roofing, carpentry, drywalling, digging and building steps, insulating, painting, flooring, replacing windows and doors, and other facets of home repair. I understand that these activities may involve the use of power tools such as saws and drills as well as the use of hand tools. The foregoing activities may also require climbing up and down ladders with and without supplies, tools, and materials; working in high places such as on roofs; and other facets of construction work. I understand that participants will be working at work sites or premises owned by third-persons, which premises may contain hazardous conditions not unknown or disclosed to Cross-Walk Ministries, Inc., TeenServe and Co-Sponsor Teams.

I understand that these activities involve a risk of injury, or even death, and Cross-Walk Ministries cannot guarantee my safety or the safety of my child. I hereby agree to freely and expressly assume and accept any and all risks of injury or death to myself or my child while participating in the Mission Experience.

Note: Participants aren't required to do any work that they feel is unsafe or they are uncomfortable doing.

Further, authorization and permission are hereby given to said organization to furnish transportation, food, and lodging for, and to assign work projects to, this participant.

I also hereby grant permission to TeenServe and Cross-Walk Ministries, Inc. to photograph and/or videotape and to record my or my child participant's voice and sounds, and to use any or all such photographs, recordings, and reproductions thereof (in and/or as a part of) any motion picture, video production, website, and/or any related published products.

If the participant has not attained the age of 18 years:

I am the parent or legal guardian of this participant and am authorized to execute this release, and hereby grant my permission for him (her) to participate fully in said workcamp, and hereby give my permission for nonprescription medication (for example, Tylenol) and routine nonsurgical medical care to be given to my child if deemed advisable by the supervising workcamp staff personnel, and to take said participant to a doctor or hospital, and hereby authorize medical treatment, including, but not limited to, emergency surgery or medical treatment, and assume the responsibility of all medical bills, if any, in excess of any applicable medical insurance coverage provided through this workcamp program. Further, should it be necessary for the participant to return home due to disciplinary action, for medical reasons, or otherwise, I hereby assume all transportation costs.

RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS

In consideration for being accepted by TeenServe and Cross-Walk Ministries, Inc., a non-profit Wisconsin Corporation, hereafter called TeenServe, for participation in this TeenServe Workcamp, I, being 18 years of age or older, do for myself and for and on behalf of my child-participant (if said child is not 18 years of age or older) hereby release, forever discharge, and agree to forever hold harmless TeenServe, Cross-Walk Ministries, Inc., the directors, officers, employees, and agents thereof, from any and all liability, claims, and demands for personal injury, sickness, and death, as well as property damage and expenses of any nature whatsoever and any loss or damage in connection with or arising out of or resulting from any or all activities engaged in by me and/or my child-participant while participating in the TeenServe Workcamp, during the time period specified above.

I agree not to make a claim or to sue Cross-Walk Ministries, Inc., TeenServe or Co-Sponsor Teams, for injuries or damages relating to my or my child's participation in TeenServe Workcamp for the period of time specified in the above paragraph.

I have carefully read this permission authorization and release of all claims, and fully understand its contents. I am aware that this is a release of liability and a contract between myself, my child and Cross-Walk Ministries, Inc., TeenServe and Co-Sponsor Teams, and I sign it of my own free will.

The undersigned further agrees to hold harmless and indemnify TeenServe, Cross-Walk Ministries, Inc., or Co-Sponsor Teams, their directors, officers, employees, and agents, for any loss, claim, liability, damage, including property damage and all other injury whatsoever incurred by the child-participant, as a result of the negligent, willful, or intentional acts of said participant, including reasonable attorneys' fees and other expenses incurred attendant thereto.

This **Release of all Claims** shall be construed and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Wisconsin. I expressly agree that this Release is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of Wisconsin, and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect. All of the provisions of this Release are separable, so if any provision of this Release is held to be ineffective by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this Release shall remain in full force and effect unless the invalidated provision is so fundamental to this Release that the remaining provisions do not reflect the parties' intent.

I have read and understand the Code of Conduct and agree to abide by the rules as listed in the Code of Conduct. I am aware that if I fail to abide by these rules I may be denied the privilege of participating in this workcamp and sent home at my parent's expense. I realize that any funds contributed to this event will be forfeited.

TEEN WORKCAMPER CODE OF CONDUCT

So that TeenServe can provide the best possible workcamp experience for all participants, we require that everyone adheres to the following Code of Conduct.

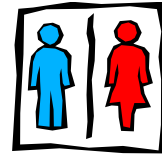
Failure to abide by any of the following policies may result in you being BV'd (this stands for "Bon Voyage" or "See Ya Later"). If you are BV'd, any travel expenses from the workcamp to your home will be the responsibility of your parents or guardians.

- ✓ Be on time for all scheduled activities. Hey, we don't want you to miss anything!
- ✓ Speaking of time, it is very important that you get the rest you need, so abide by the 10:30 p.m. lights out time. Your neighbors may need their beauty sleep.
- ✓ No illegal drugs, alcohol, or tobacco products. No fireworks or weapons. No pornography. (Use or Possession). No fighting.
- ✓ No profanity - All of your actions must display a Christian example. You are representing God, TeenServe and your church.
- ✓ Your Youth Leader must know where you are at all times. No participant under the age of 18 is allowed to leave the school premises without an adult's permission and supervision.
- ✓ No skateboards allowed!
- ✓ Teen participants are not allowed to have portable electronic items (i.e. IPODs, laptops and cell phones) at the worksite. Leave these items at home or in your youth group's vehicle. One of TeenServe's goals is to help you build relationships with your youth group and with the members of your crew. It's hard to carry on a conversation with a wire stuck in your ear!
- ✓ Report all illnesses to your Crew Leader or Youth Leader. We have a health care professional on staff and he or she will be happy to talk to you if you aren't feeling well!
- ✓ Commit to maintaining a positive attitude regardless of the circumstances. Your attitude can make or break your crew! Don't worry, be happy!



RELATIONSHIPS...

- ✓ No romantic, dating relationships or pairing off will be allowed at any time. If you are in a dating relationship, you must put it on hold for the week. This is a time to minister to others and you don't need the distraction!
- ✓ No romantic physical contact.
 - includes holding hands, extended hugs
 - no guy and girl prayer alone
- ✓ No guys in girls' rooms or hallway and no girls in guys' rooms or hallway.



FACILITIES...

- ✓ Each Youth Group will be responsible for any damage done to the classrooms/ sleeping rooms. **THE SCHOOL MUST BE TREATED LIKE A CASTLE.**
- ✓ Rooms must be kept clean and orderly. No food and pop will be allowed in the classrooms. Keep all dirty tools out of the classrooms. **AND**, please wipe your shoes off before entering the school!



DRESS CODE



“Why a Dress Code,” you ask? TeenServe wants to keep you as safe and undistracted as possible while on the worksite and at the school. We witness to the Lord via our appearance as well as our actions.

- ✓ No clothing that advertises alcohol, tobacco products, or heavy metal bands...even Christian ones (your resident may not know the difference)!
- ✓ Girls...No short skirts or short shorts.
- ✓ Girls...All shirts must cover your waist - this includes when you are reaching upward to paint!
- ✓ No tube tops, tank tops, low cut shirts, sports bras or bikinis. Sleeveless t-shirts or shirts are great!
- ✓ Wear comfortable and durable shoes on the worksite. No flip flops or sandals allowed on the worksite.
- ✓ Don't wear excessively baggy pants...could be dangerous on the worksite.
- ✓ Guys...You must wear a shirt at all times.
- ✓ EVERYONE...Please travel fully covered to and from the locker rooms...no pajamas or towels to be used as clothing!
- ✓ Just use your common sense...These "rules" are put into place so that we can be a witness to the Lord at all times!
